Message Notes – 2 Corinthians 10

**Key Verse:** 2 Corinthians 10:1-2

1 Now I, Paul, myself am pleading with you by the meekness and gentleness of Christ, who in presence am lowly among you, but being absent am bold toward you.

2 But I beg you that when I am present I may not be bold with that confidence by which I intend to be bold against some, who think of us as if we walked according to the flesh.

**Sermon Summary:** Embrace the meekness and gentleness of Christ, defend the truth of the gospel against false teachings, and focus on glorifying the Lord in all we do.

**Major Points:**

1. Meekness and Gentleness of Christ: Follow the example of Christ who exercised power under control, inviting us to learn from Him in Matthew 11:29.
2. Defending the Gospel: Paul defends his apostolic authority against false teachers in Corinth, emphasizing the importance of standing firm against ideologies that exalt themselves against the knowledge of God.
3. Spiritual Warfare: Our weapons are spiritual and mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, focusing on bringing every thought into obedience to Christ.
4. Avoid Comparison: Do not boast beyond measure or compare yourself with others, but focus on what God has called you to do and support one another in ministry.
5. Glorify the Lord: True glory comes from the Lord, not from the approval of others or self-commendation.



### **Action Steps:**

1. Immerse yourself in God's Word, be diligent in prayer, and surround yourself with a community of believers for accountability.
2. Recognize your unique calling and sphere of influence, focusing on what God has appointed you to do and supporting others in their ministries.
3. Seek to glorify the Lord in all you do, resting in the assurance that your approval comes from Him alone.
