Resurrection Sunday

Opening: Today's sermon is based on **John 3:16**, focusing on the profound love of God. And what love He demonstrated as we celebrate our risen Lord!

Luke 24:6 - 'He is not here; he has risen! Remember how he told you, while he was still with you in Galilee.'

Key Points:

- God's authority to love the world stems from His divine nature as the Creator. His love is unconditional and stems from His very being.
- The love expressed in John 3:16 is agape love, selfless and sacrificial, seeking the best for others.
- Believing in Jesus goes beyond intellectual assent, it requires trust and confidence in Him.
- God gave His Son as a priceless gift out of His immense love for us, demonstrating the depth of His love.
- Those who believe in Jesus should not perish but have everlasting life, emphasizing the guarantee of eternal life with Him.
- The word "so" in John 3:16 is not about the size of God's love but about the manner in which He loves, comparing it to the saving act of the bronze serpent in the wilderness.
- God's love in giving His Son is a practical expression of His love for the world, showing the extent of His sacrificial and selfless love.
- Believing in Jesus is about actively trusting and committing to Him, not just acknowledging His existence.



- The contrast in John 3:16 highlights the choice between perishing without God and having everlasting life with Him.
- Eternity with Jesus in heaven is described as a place of joy, abundance, and being in the presence of God.

Action Steps:

1. Trust in Jesus and have confidence in Him, not just intellectual belief.
2. Receive God's gift of salvation by believing in His Son and committing to a personal relationship with Him.
3. How has your life changed since you came to Jesus?
4. What did you learn from today's message?
